

**Fredericton North Heritage Association
General Meeting, March 10, 2026: Minutes**

Program: Jill has stepped away from organizing the monthly meetings. Fred has stepped up to get speakers for the next few months. He is looking for suggestions from the members.

April will probably feature Randall Hazlitt speaking on his search for his father's downed plane (WWII) and Fred will ask Bob McNeil to present his new book in May. In June we will have the usual BBQ.
